

## Work and Jobs Federal Bonding Program

If you are concerned that employers may not be interested in hiring you, consider exploring the Federal Bonding Program (FBP). The U.S. Department of Labor provides a bonding program <u>free</u> of charge for the first six months of employment. It was created for "high risk" employees, often used for people who have a felony offense.

The application process is simple and can help employers feel more comfortable hiring a person who may look risky on paper.
